



## **General Benefits**

### **Access to National Sports Centres**

BOA Passport Holders can access the National Sport Centres on a free of charge basis for training. Please note this is for individuals only and does not apply to squads or groups. Information attached.

### **Access to Local Sports Centres**

The BOA will negotiate, on behalf of the BOA Passport Holders, with local sports centres to help gain free of charge access to training facilities for the athletes supplementary training. Again this is on an individual basis and not for squads or groups.

All you need to do is identify a gym/centre that is able to provide you with the type of access and facilities you require, the centre can be privately owned or run by a local authority. Once you have identified a centre let us know the name of the Manager and the full address of the centre and we will write to ask for their co-operation in allowing you to use the facilities without charge. Please note that once negotiated, your card will only give you free access to your nominated local sports centre/gym, it does not entitle you to free access to other sports centres that participate in the scheme. Unfortunately a free training arrangement cannot always be guaranteed.

### **Access to Olympic Medical Institute**

BOA Passport Holders can by appointment receive medical services at the Olympic Medical Institute at Northwick Park Hospital, Watford Road, Harrow, Middlesex HA1 3UJ Tel: 020 8423 7200 This will include consultation and out patient's treatment. An advisory service will be available for exercise physiology, nutrition and psychology.
