## About Somerset Disabled C.C

Somerset Disabled Cricket Club was formed in 1997 in partnership with the Somerset County Cricket Club. Our Club now has over 25 active players, with an experienced County Championship squad featuring a number of England Internationals.

We welcome members of all ages and abilities and are proud of our reputation for including players of all types of physical and learning impairments. Our Club is run by disabled people for disabled people.

Free open coaching sessions are held at either the Centre of Excellence at the County Ground in Taunton, or at Taunton School. Our qualified coaches are experienced in working with disabled players.



The safety compound ball we use is an Easton Incrediball. It looks and behaves like a standard cricket ball.

New players do not need to buy their own equipment when they join, as this is provided. The Club strip is issued to team members in return for a small deposit, refundable on return to the Club.

## Our Club continued....

Our club competes in an ECB funded County Championship. This enables our Championship squad to travel to other counties for away matches, as well as playing home games at Taunton Civil Service Club, Trull Road, Taunton.

In November we hold our Annual Awards Dinner, at which trophies are awarded in a range of categories
