Special Schools Sports Festival

What is it?

SASSOT hold an annual Special Schools Sports Festival at Shobnall Leisure Complex, Burton-upon-Trent during Youth Sport Trust's National School Sport week.

The festival is a day to celebrate sport and to develop pathways for pupils to continue to take part in sport outside of the school environment. SASSOT works on a number of disability sport programmes and has produced a 'Disability Sport and Activity' guide for children who want to experience the benefits of sport and physical activity.

NGBs can choose to be fully involved as a participation sport on the day, organise a taster session, have a stall or display promoting their sport or to have information about their sport (especially local opportunities for disabled participants) included in the Disability Sport and Activity Guide.
