

SASSOT Clubmark / QualityMark

What is it?

One of the main aims of SASSOT's Club Support Plan is to increase the number of high quality accredited clubs throughout the sub-region.

SASSOT are licensed to accredit clubs with Clubmark that do not affiliate to a licensed NGB. SASSOT have also developed a club accreditation award called QualityMark; this is for sports clubs that are not eligible to apply for their NGB or SASSOT Clubmark accreditation.

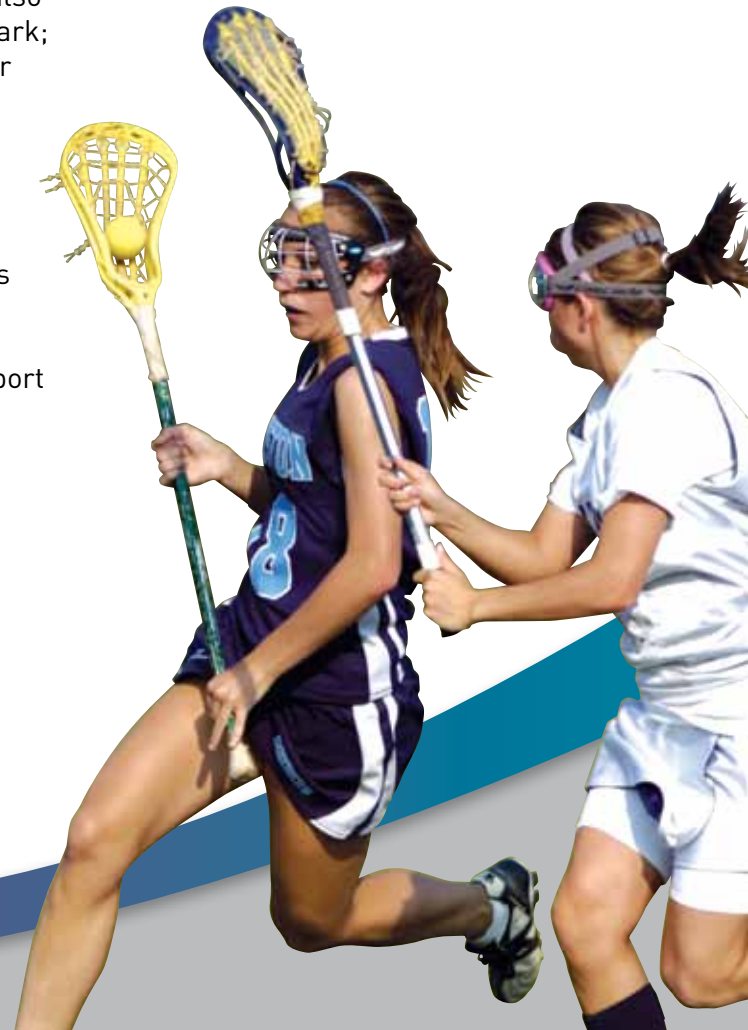
The SASSOT QualityMark criteria is aligned with the Clubmark standards in order to ensure that the schemes complement each other and sports clubs that achieve this award will receive similar benefits as associated with Clubmark.

Clubs working towards accreditation can receive support and advice from SASSOT.

Step into Sport

What is it?

SASSOT works with the 10 School Sport Partnerships in the sub-region on the Step into Sport programme through their Leadership Academies. Step into Sport aims to increase the quantity, quality and diversity of young people engaged in volunteering and leadership, with consequent benefits to schools, sports clubs, the community and the young people themselves.

Step into Sport is the tool, which enables schools to grow young people as leaders and deploy them as active volunteers both within the school and community settings.

SASSOT engages with NGBs in the provision of volunteer placements in high quality community clubs for these young people.
