Format: One round of pools + Direct Elimination. All pool fights will be to 5 hits and last up to 3 minutes. All DE fights at U11 & U14 will be fenced to 10 hits with 3 bouts of 2 minutes; U17 & U20 will fence to 15 hits with 3 bouts of 3 minutes.

There will be medals for 1st, 2nd & joint 3rd place in all age groups. Mixed gender pools may be fought depending on numbers entering each event, but separate medals will be awarded to boys and girls.

EPEE & SABRE

The competition will be fenced all electric scoring. All fencers' equipment must conform to British Fencing standard i.e. U11 Foil only minimum of 350N jacket & plastron, tracksuit trousers (pockets must be taped); all other weapons and age groups, 350N jacket, plastron & breeches; 800N plastrons must be worn by U14 and above. All girls must wear chest protectors.

Note that the organisers may use photography on the day for publicity and training purposes.

The organisers reserve the right to reject kit of any fencer on safety grounds.

THE STONYHURST SCHOOLS CHALLENGE TROPHY



Rules:

1. Ages are based upon age on 1st January 2010. (U11 born 1999 or later, U14 > 1996, U17 >1993)
2. Points will be awarded starting at 1 and increasing by 1 for each successive position from the bottom position.
3. Medal winners will count as (Position x 1.1) for Bronze, x 1.2 for Silver and x 1.5 for Gold.
4. The school with the highest total number of points will win the Challenge.
5. Individuals may enter from any fencing club or school BUT challenge points may only be accumulated by schools.
6. For schools in NW region points accumulated will also count towards the new BFNWR Schools Challenge Trophy to be awarded in autumn based upon the Lancashire Schools, Cheshire & Wrexham Schools, NWJS, & BYC Qualifiers.
