Nomination Categories



Young Female Achiever

For girls aged 18 and under at 31 December who have been successful at club, regional or national competitions.

Young Male Achiever

For boys aged 18 and under at 31 December who have been successful at club, regional or national competitions.

Coach

A person who has made a significant contribution to improving the standard of performance in any sport for disabled athletes.

Team

Applies to all age groups and includes clubs or regional representative teams of two or more players achieving a notable standard of performance.

School of the Year

Applies to schools which participate in a wide range of sporting activities and actively encourage pupils of all abilities. This award does not necessarily go to the school who has won the most competitions or trophies.

Volunteer

This can be a person or couple who have helped a sporting individual, group or club in any supporting role. They could have been the "drinks maker," a "mini bus driver" or "general helper". The nominee/s would have been involved on a regular basis.

Sports Club

A club or group that has introduced the provision of sport and physical activities for its members. This may be an established or new club.

Male Sports Personality of the Year

Applies to all age groups and includes sports people who have achieved at regional, national or international level.

Female Sports Personality of the Year

Applies to all age groups and includes sports people who have achieved at regional, national or international level.

Ambassador of Disability Sport

Individuals who have made a significant contribution to the development of sport and demonstrated a strong commitment to raising the profile of sport for disabled people.
